

## What's New in F&B Control v6.0

**F&B Control** is continuously being developed to provide enhancements to existing functionality and add new features for better inventory operations and transaction management.

### Enhancements and Modifications in v6.0 Database Version 38603

#### Purchasing

##### Requisition

- Added a new feature ***"Split Requisition"*** so that you could split requisition for one product to different suppliers

##### Delivery Receipt

- Added the possibility to allow users to create delivery receipt and Invoice at the same time without the need of creating Delivery Receipt first. If suppliers do not issue Delivery Receipts but only issues Invoice that serves as DR as well, the user will not have to pass through the creation of DR then link it to Invoice anymore, they have the option to create Invoice and DR at the same time.

#### Configuration

##### Options & Preferences

- Users that have license to Supplier Network can set the Customer ID under General Settings tab for sending Purchase Order file to Selly Solution. (Selly Solution is only applicable for German clients)

##### Manage Categories

- Move and Up and Down Buttons were added in the **"Manage Categories"** form. Multiple categories can also be highlighted from the list to move its hierarchy.

#### Import Products

- Improved efficiency/speed of product importation.
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## Reset Stock

- Removed the following checkboxes in Reset Stock Form:
  1. Delete Users (*except for "Administrators"*)
  2. Delete Log

## Reports

### Modified Report

- Added "**Non-Sales Quantity**" column in Actual Food Cost Report. Non-sales items are those issued or consumed from stock but were not actually sold such as give-away, gifts, samples, employee meals, and the likes.
  - In the Printing Options form, "**Location**" filter is now enabled for Stock Status and Consumption Report preview. Also, Grouped by Location was added in the said report.
  - In the Printing Options form, a "**Without Invoice**" filter option was added to filter Delivery Receipts not yet linked to an Invoice.
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## What's New in RecipeNet/Calcmenu 2004 v6.0

**RecipeNet** and **CALCMENU 2004** are continuously being developed to provide enhancements to existing functionality and add new features for better recipe management.

### Enhancements and Modifications in v6.0 Database Version 38603

#### Merchandise, Recipes and Menus

- The "**Flour**" option for merchandise (*used for Bakers Percentage*) is now known as "**Basic baking ingredient**". This is to avoid confusion that users can use other ingredients other than flour as basic ingredient in the baking formulation.
  - Added the possibility to search merchandise using keywords when creating a recipe. Users can use it by clicking "**Add Ingredient**" in the Recipe Details form and check (tick) the "**Show Options**", he or she can find two tabs namely, "**Filter**" and "**Keyword**". Go to the "**Keyword**" tab to begin.
  - A new feature, "**Adapt Yield To Ingredient**", was added in the Recipe and Menu Details forms to adapt recipe and menu size based on a desired ingredient quantity. Right click the ingredient that you want the quantity to change and specify the new quantity desired. The program will then recalculate the new yield of the recipe or menu based on this new quantity as well as the new quantity of the other ingredients in the list).
  - Only an Administrator can now set up the email account for users. The email account details can be accessed when creating new users or modifying information about existing users.
  - **For RecipeNet:** Improved labor cost, which when double clicked will load the sub-recipe's labor cost details. Also, labor cost now includes notes/details of the labor.
  - **For RecipeNet:** Added Translation button so that recipe and menu ingredients can be translated in other languages.
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## Recipe Exchange

The Recipe Exchange feature that was previously linked to the Recipe List window is now accessible through its own window/form. Users can now directly access the Recipe Exchange button in the main toolbar. Also, it can be accessed in the Recipe drop down menu option.

- You can add recipes to your database by downloading recipes from our EGS Recipe Database, using the first free 200 points that are initially given to all EGS RecipeNet and EGS CALCMENU 2004 owners (one serial number = 200 points regardless on the number of licenses owned or users specified in the software).
- Each recipe has corresponding costs to it. The costs will be deducted to your remaining points as you download.
- Sub-recipes of the main recipe have no costs, so it will not be considered when deducting points from your balance.
- To earn more points you should upload your own recipes to our EGS Database (recipes must be approved by EGS before you can earn points) so that everybody can exchange recipes with each other.
- You can use Category and Source filters search recipes online
- To determine the top rated recipes, here are the criteria:
  1. Average rating
  2. Total number of ratings
  3. Total number of downloads
  4. With picture
- Rating a local recipe will automatically update the rating of its online counterpart.
- User cannot download and upload recipes using a demo/30-day trial version.
- In recipe preview, **"units"** are now displayed in the language of the recipe instead of in English only.
- The download of pictures for Recipe Exchange has been updated.
  1. User can preview the picture to be downloaded
  2. Up to 3 recipe pictures can now be downloaded
  3. Up to 3 pictures can now be previewed together with the recipe's ingredients and procedure.

### Options & Preferences

- Only the Administrator can modify the picture settings.
- Only the Administrator can modify the nutrient database.

## Print

User can now make use of the newly improved printing options, where they can set and adjust the margin, line spacing, font style & size, etc. for each printing style that they want.

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
